



## **euroFOT Final Event, Brussels, 26-27 June 2012**

For 48 months now, car manufacturers, automotive suppliers, universities, research centres and European organisations have joined forces to assess the impact and benefits of ICT-based active safety systems on traffic safety and efficiency, in a project co-funded the EC – DG INFSO.

On 26 and 27 June 2012, the euroFOT Final Event will be held at the Autoworld Museum (Brussels) and the unprecedented results of this one-off project will be unveiled to the public.

euroFOT is the first large-scale European Field Operational Test on active safety systems, and a global leader in Field Operational Tests on ICT technologies. For 12 months, 1,000 cars and trucks equipped with a range of 8 safety features travelled 30 million kilometres on European roads. With 1,200 drivers volunteering to test the systems, and to have data acquisition systems installed in their vehicles, hundreds of terabytes of data were collected that are now being analysed by some of the 28 euroFOT partners.
